
DAY FOUR

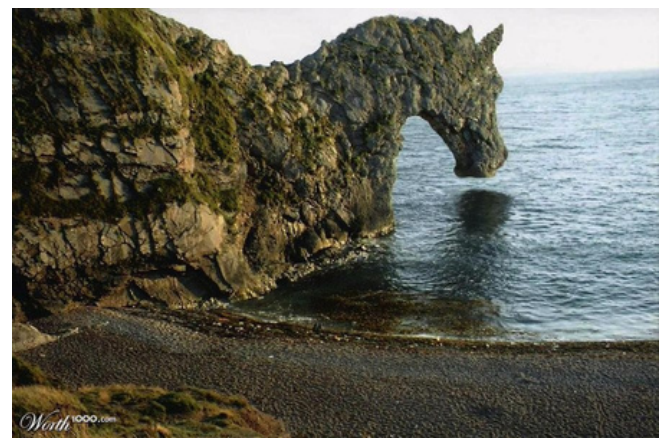
Now tell your tale... (by poem, story, comic strip or song!)
